## Fact Sheet

**What:** Teatro ZinZanni is an original show combining European cirque, cabaret, spectacle and live music served with a five-course feast designed by celebrated Northwest chef Tom Douglas.

The show is presented in a gorgeous, climate-controlled antique cabaret tent (known as a *spiegel tent*) Imported from Belgium, the tent is nicknamed the *Moulin Rouge*. Built in 1910, it boasts stained glass, hand-carved wooden interior columns, polished crystal and mirrors. Guests are seated restaurant-style in this unique venue, and the action of the show takes place throughout the circular structure. The *Moulin Rouge* comfortably seats 285 guests. The show runs approximately three hours.

**Where:** Teatro ZinZanni is located at 222 Mercer Street, in Seattle Center's Theatre District at 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue North and Mercer Street.

**When:** Performances are Wednesday through Saturday evenings at 6:30 p.m. and Sundays at 7:30 p.m. Single tickets are sold up to eight weeks in advance. Groups of 20 and more may make reservations any time by calling Group Sales at 206.802.0013.

**Who:** Our show changes every three or four months.
